

# BASIC GUIDE

## MINE BITCOIN WATER

To start setting up your wallet and be able to mine Bitcoin Water we will run and extract the "Bitcoinwater\_Miner.zip" file we just downloaded.

- Inside the folder "Bitcoinwater\_Miner" we will find the file "install.bat", we execute it and wait for the program to install the necessary files, once finished we close the window.
- Once the installation is finished, we will find a folder called "Bitcoinwater" on the desktop, open it and run the file "bitcoinwater-qt.exe", this file will open the platform to create and configure our wallet (you can create as many wallets as you need).
- Once the platform has started, we go to "File>Create wallet", here we choose a name for our wallet and select "Create", our wallet will be configured to store our Bitcoin Water.
- To synchronise the miner with our wallet we go to "Configuration>Options", there we select "Open configuration file", we open it with Notepad, and we paste the following text:

```
rpcuser=rpc_bitcoinwater rpcpassword=dR2oBQ3K1zYMZQtIFZeAerhWxaJ5Lqeq9J2  
rpcbind=0.0.0.0  
rpcallowip=127.0.0.1  
listen=1  
server=1  
addnode=node2.walletbuilders.com
```

**"File>Save"** and close the Notepad.

- To start the miner, run the "mine.bat" file, the miner will start and open the wallet for storage. If the wallet is already running, the miner will start mining Bitcoin Water automatically.
